ADSBS Rules For Registry

Member Code

This is the six-digit code assigned to your name.

Breeder

The breeder of a lamb is the person who owned the dam at the time she was bred.

Owner

The owner of a lamb is the person who owned the dam at that the time she lambed. The Owner is responsible for registration. A "breeding certificate" is required if the person who is considered the owner does not own the sire (i.e. if you borrowed or leased the sire, the owner of the sire must sign a "breeding certificate". Note! The owner of the ram is not the breeder in this situation.

Flock Name

Represented by a name you choose to register your new animals. Your private flock name will remain on record unless a change is requested, in writing.

Dorper/White Dorper

White Dorpers and Dorpers (black head) cannot be crossed. Color type must be specified (X) when registering lambs. Note! Use separate "application for registrations" for different color types.

Office Use

Please leave this column blank.

EWE or RAM

Circle if the animal that you are registering is a EWE or a RAM.

Tag Number

List the tag number in the animals' ear.

Permanent Identification (if any)

If you would like the tattoo, scrapie tag number, or electronic implant to be printed on the registration certificate, please fill in this column. If you choose to list a scrapie ID or other tag in this field, and later must re-tag the animal, you will be charged a correction fee to correct the certificate.

BET = Both ears tattoo

RET = Right ear tattoo

LET = Left ear tattoo

BFT = Both flanks tattoo

RFT = Right flank tattoo

LFT = Left flank tattoo

ST= Scrapie Tag

EID = Microchip/Electronic ID

Birth Date

The date the animal was born. Must include the month, day and year.

Type of Birth

S = Single

QD=Quadruplet

TW=Twins

QT=Quintuplet

TR=Triplet

ET=Embryo Transfer

% (Percent)

FB = Fullblood, PB = Pureblood or % = Percentage animal.

AI (Artificial Insemination)

Dorpers born as a result of AI must be designated by placing "X" in the AI column. If the breeder does not own the ram from which semen was used, a "Certificate of Semen Transfer", signed by the owner of the ram, must be submitted with the application for registration.

Embryo Transfer (ET)

I=Imported Embryo

D=Domestic Embryo

N=Not the result of Embryo Transfer

Sire's Flock Name and Number

List the sire's flock name and number as it appears on the ADSBS certificate.

Sire's Registration Number

List the sire's registration number as it appears on the ADSBS certificate. If the sire is a Canadian registered animal, send a copy of the Sire's Canadian certificate.

Lambs from Multiple Sire Group

Enclose a "Multiple Sire Breeding Group Form" and see "ADSBS Regulations and Procedures" for details.

Dam's Flock Name and Number

List the dam's flock name and number as it appears on the ADSBS certificate.

Dam's Flock Name and Number if a Foundation Ewe

List the dam's flock name and number of the Foundation Ewe

Dam's Registration Number

List the dam's registration number as it appears on the ADSBS certificate. If the dam is a Canadian registered animal, send a copy of the dam's Canadian certificate.

Dam's Registration Number if a Foundation Ewe

List the genetic makeup of the Foundation Ewe.

Lambs From Foundation Ewes

Enclose a "Certificate of Foundation Ewe(s) Sold" form if the Foundation Ewes were purchased. See "ADSBS Regulations and Procedures" for more details.

Transfer of Ownership

If the Dorper being registered has been sold, indicate the date of sale and the exact name, and address of purchaser. Animals will be transferred upon registration, if accompanied by a transfer fee.

September 1, 2005-Any animal that is transferred, the registration certificate(s) will be mailed to the purchaser from the ADSBS office.

Lambs From Foundation Ewes or Multiple Sire Groups

Disqualifying Faults
