

2024 South African Flock Inspections

South African Certified Dorper Judges and Inspectors

- ♦ The Inspection costs \$400 per day, plus \$2 for each ADSBS tag used (ADSBS will bill breeders directly for each tag, after inspection information arrives at the office). This fee represents \$300 for the Inspector, \$25 for South African Dorper Society, and \$75 for flight costs for inspector's travel expense.
- ♦ Any breeders consigning animals to the Sunflower Classic Show & Sale or the Western States Show & Sale will not be able to have flock inspections before these two events. Consigners could be schedule for flock inspections on dates after these events.
- ♦ Two breeders can split an Inspection day if they live close to each other and have less than 25 sheep to inspect. If splitting an inspection day; each breeder will need to fill out the form.
- ♦ Complete the flock inspection form and your check, **made payable to Mid American Dorper Breeders.**
Mail the flock inspection form and check to: Freddy Rossouw, 1677 E 250 Lane, Phillipsburg, KS 67661, in order to be added to the schedule. Inspection form and payment must be received by March 29th. First come first serve. There will be no inspections added after the schedule is completed.

Spending a day with an Inspector is an excellent in-person educational opportunity, so ask as many questions about your flock and breeding program as possible!
