Carcass Contest National Show and Sale April 18-20, 2024 | Duncan, Oklahoma

There will be a Carcass Contest in Duncan this year with live evaluation as well as judging of the carcasses in the cooler.

Rules and Schedule:

All entries must be registered Dorper, White Dorper or a cross between the two.

Maximum live weight is 100 lbs.

All entries must have a registration certificate or a signed and filled out "Application for Registration" form. We realize the animal you bring may be a late addition since we have a weight limit.

Rams, ewes, and wethers are acceptable.

Health papers are required.

Washing and clipping of sheep is not mandatory.

The only entry fee is the registration fee.

Consignments are limited to the first 50 head.

Sheep must be in the barn by **noon** on Thursday.

Juniors and adults can evaluate the sheep and choose the sheep they think will win.

There will be prizes for the Juniors.

Sheep will be transported to the packer.

The sheep will be harvested on Friday, Judged on Saturday.

The consignors will be paid on the packer's grid. All proceeds will go to the ADSBS for distribution.

Dr. Lydia Garcia from Ohio State University will judge the contest and will present a seminar on what she is looking for in the ideal carcass. Seminar day and time is TBA.
